Onboard the Southwest Chief, you'll witness some of the most iconic geographies in the country from the comfort of your seat. From the prairies of the heartland to the painted desert palette in New Mexico and Arizona, the views are impressive and plentiful. Route highlights include Santa Fe Trail, Raton Pass, Sangre de Cristo Mountains, Sedona Red Cliffs, the Continental Divide, and of course, the magnificent Grand Canyon. The train stops in Williams, AZ near the South Rim of Grand Canyon National Park. From Williams, Amtrak passengers can be shuttled to the Grand Canyon Railroad Station to board the Grand Canyon Railway for the short, scenic journey to the Canyon's South Rim.

ENJOY THE GRAND CANYON WITHOUT THE CROWDS

EL TOVAR HOTEL IS A NATIONAL HISTORIC LANDMARK

The iconic El Tovar Hotel was built in 1905 and in 1987 it was designated a National Historic Landmark. Located on the Canyon rim, it features a fine dining room that any visitor to the Grand Canyon can enjoy with reservations where you will be able to watch the sunrise or sunset.

AWE-INSPIRING VIEWS

No matter how many stories you've heard about the grandeur and majesty of the Grand Canyon, or how many inspiring images you may have seen, nothing can prepare you for the actual, awe-inspiring sight of it. It truly is something to behold at least once in your lifetime.

UNESCO WORLD HERITAGE SITE

As a UNESCO World Heritage Site, the Grand Canyon welcomes approximately six million domestic and international visitors each year. After 100 years, whether it's hiking a corridor trail, taking a stroll on the rim, or enjoying the landscape from an overlook, Grand Canyon continues to provide a space for all visitors to connect with the outdoors.

HISTORIC STRUCTURES ABOUND

The Grand Canyon Village is home to numerous National Historic Landmarks that are listed on the National Register of Historic Places such as Grand Canyon Train Depot, El Tovar Hotel, the Buckey O'Neill Cabin, Hopi House, Lookout Studio and Hermit's Rest.

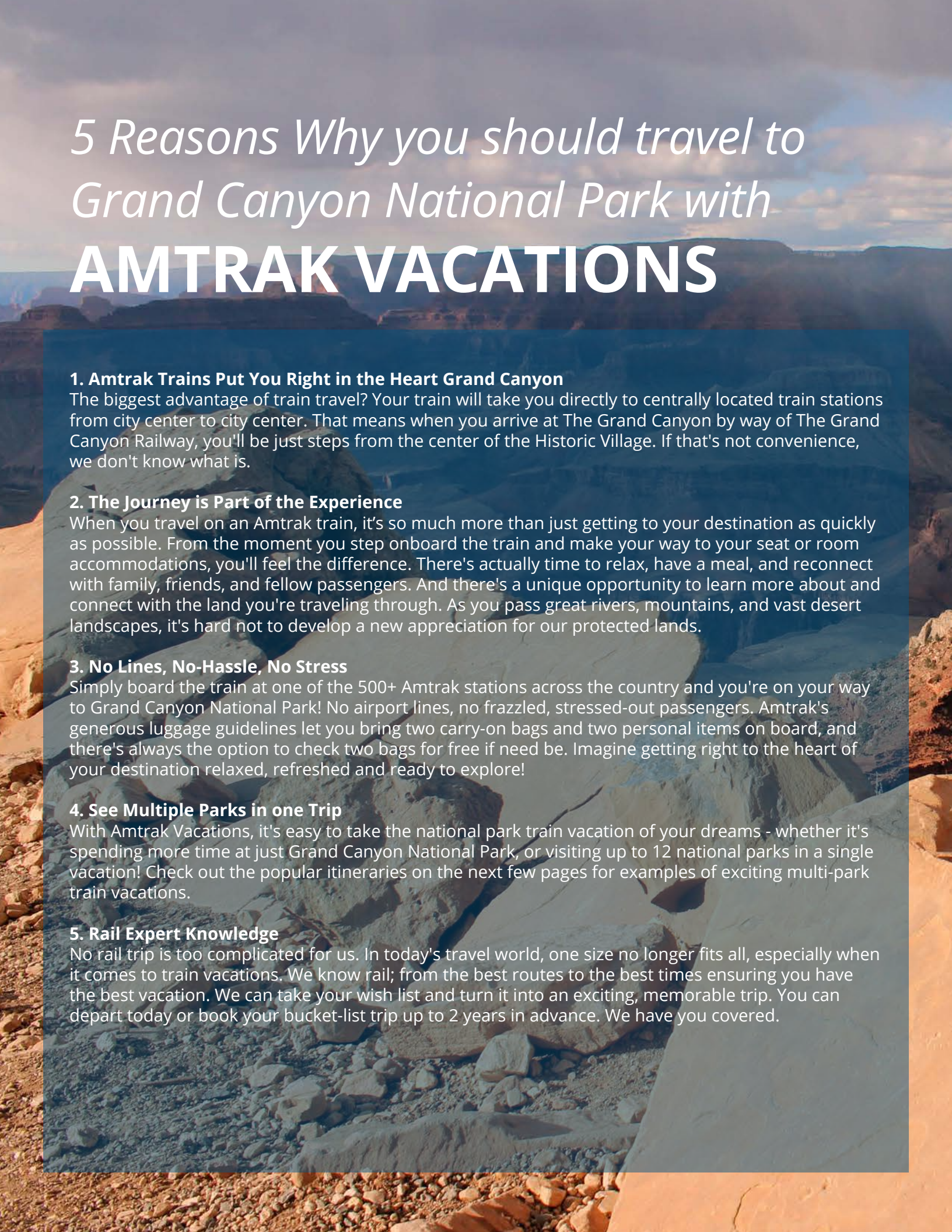

HISTORY OF EL TOVAR HOTEL

El Tovar Hotel, the premier lodging facility at the Grand Canyon, opened its doors in 1905 and was most recently renovated in 2005. El Tovar offers its guests Concierge, turn-down and room service and is a Registered National Historic Landmark.
